Postsecondary Credit Agreement/Articulation Agreement Template

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement/Articulation Agreement is made and entered into as of June 6, 2023, by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and Alpena Community College/University. The agreement is for state-approved secondary career technical education (CTE) programs. Separate agreements should be submitted for each state-approved CTE secondary CIP Code number.

Purpose of this Agreement:

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

Aligned Postsecondary/Articulated Programs and Courses:

General Conditions & Requirements:

- 1. Application for postsecondary credit must be received within two years of the student's high school graduation. Exceptions to this condition must be approved by the Registrar.
2. The postsecondary credit application will be completed and submitted by the secondary CTE program representative and student, as relevant. All supporting documentation will be submitted to Alpena Community College.
3. The high school student must earn a B or higher in the applicable CTE program to be eligible for postsecondary/articulated credit.
4. No tuition will be charged for any courses for which the student receives postsecondary/articulated credit.

Aligned Postsecondary/Articulated Courses:

Credit for students is approved for the following course(s) based upon the passage of the relevant CTE course/program or corresponding credentialing exams. All conditions and requirements must be fulfilled.
