Postsecondary Credit Agreement

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement (also known as an Articulation Agreement) is made and entered into as of January 1, 2023, by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and Northern Michigan University. The agreement is for state approved secondary Career Technical Education (CTE) programs.

Purpose of this Agreement:

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
- 2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
- 3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
- 4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

Example of General Conditions & Requirements:

- 1. Application for postsecondary credit must be received within two years of the student's high school graduation. Exceptions to this condition must be approved by (person at post-secondary level who can authorize this.)
- 2. The postsecondary credit application will be completed and submitted by the secondary CTE program representative and student, as relevant. All supporting documentation will be submitted to Office of Admissions at Northern Michigan University.
- 3. The high school student must earn a B or higher in the applicable CTE program to be eligible for postsecondary/articulated credit.
- 4. No tuition will be charged for any courses for which the student receives postsecondary/articulated credit.
